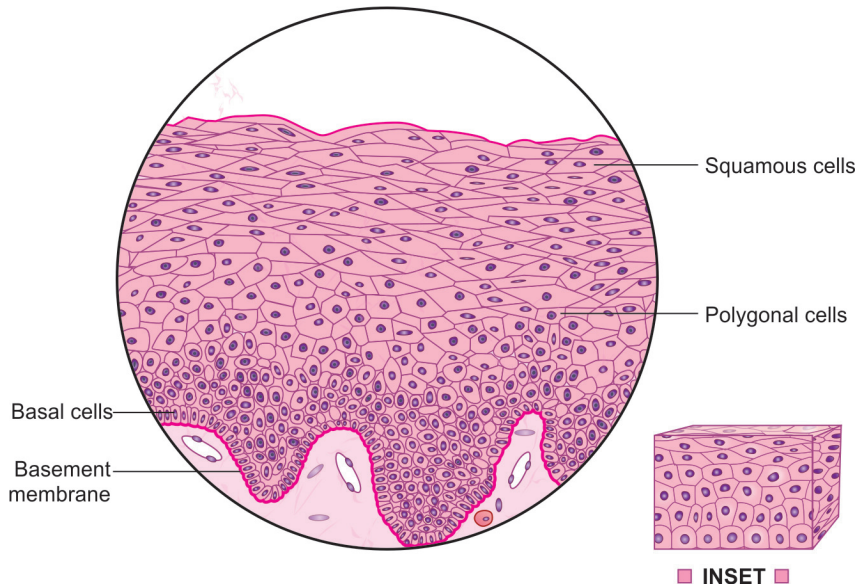


b. *Stratified squamous non-keratinised type*: Example is oesophagus; oral cavity, vagina. The cells occur in three layers or zones as follows:

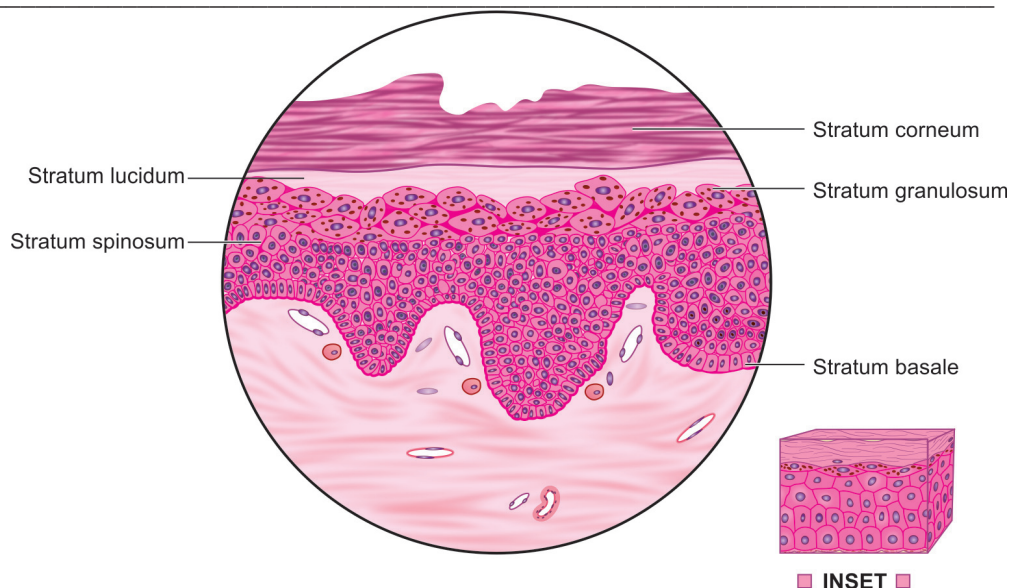


Oesophagus. Stain: Haematoxylin-eosin, 400X

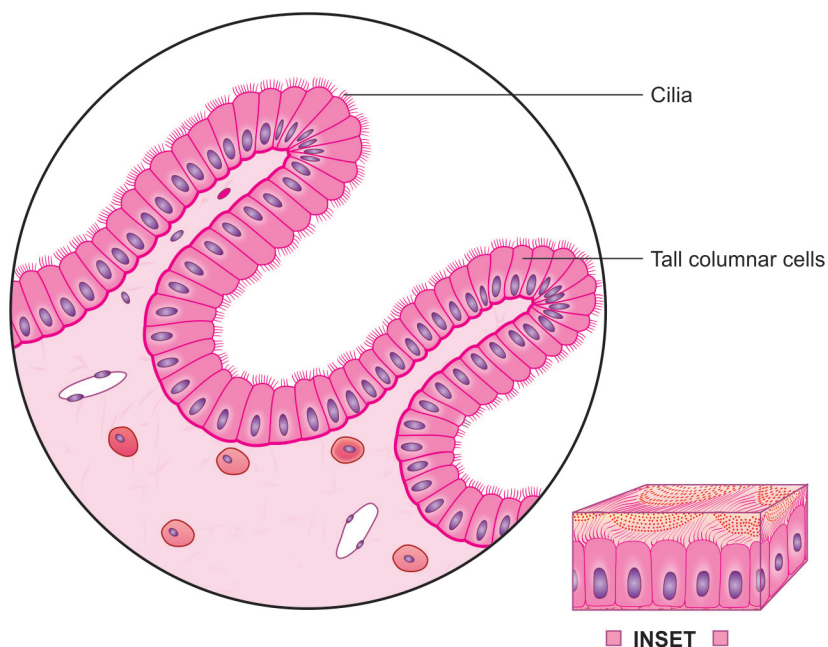
Skin. Stain: Haematoxylin-eosin, 400X

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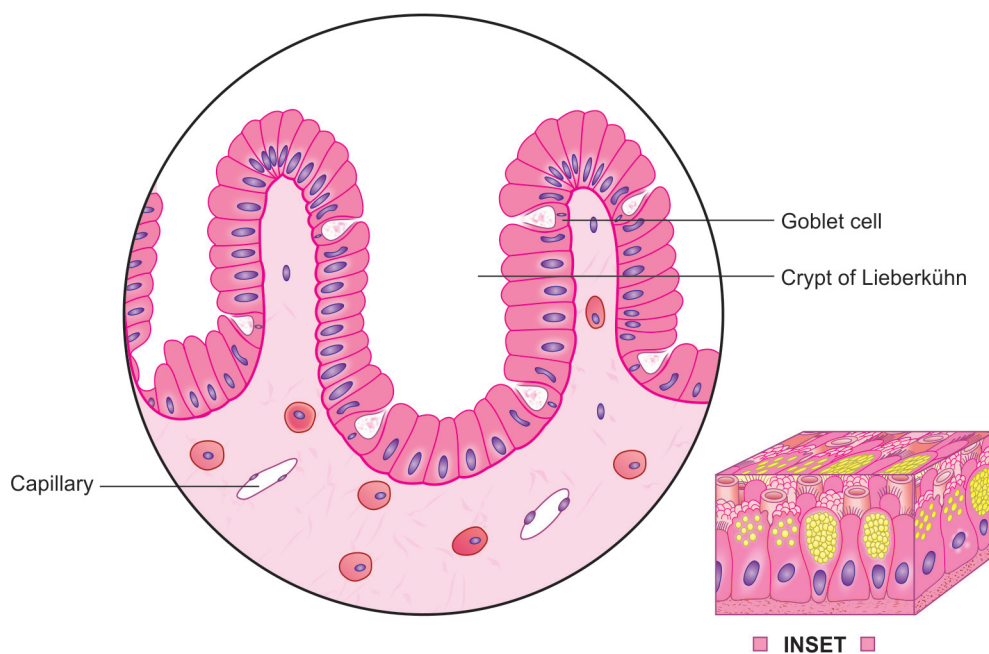

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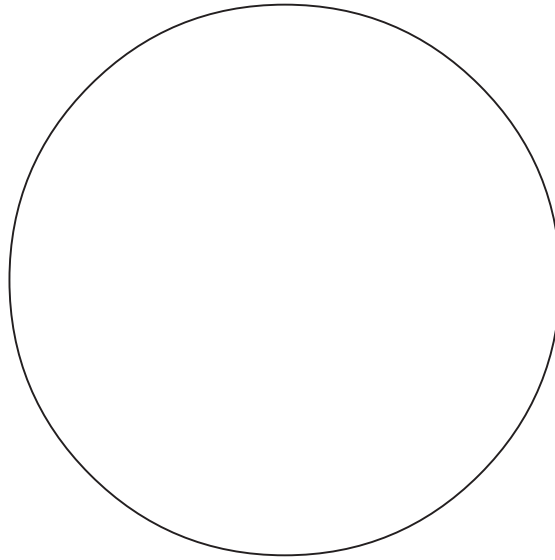


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Colon. Stain: Haematoxylin-eosin, 400X

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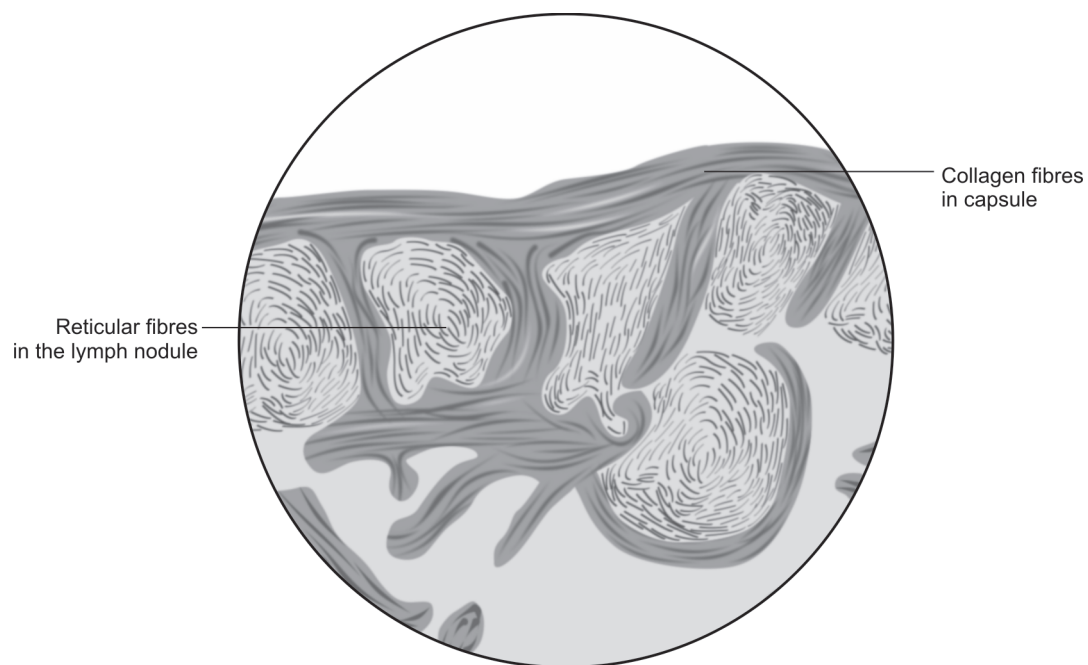

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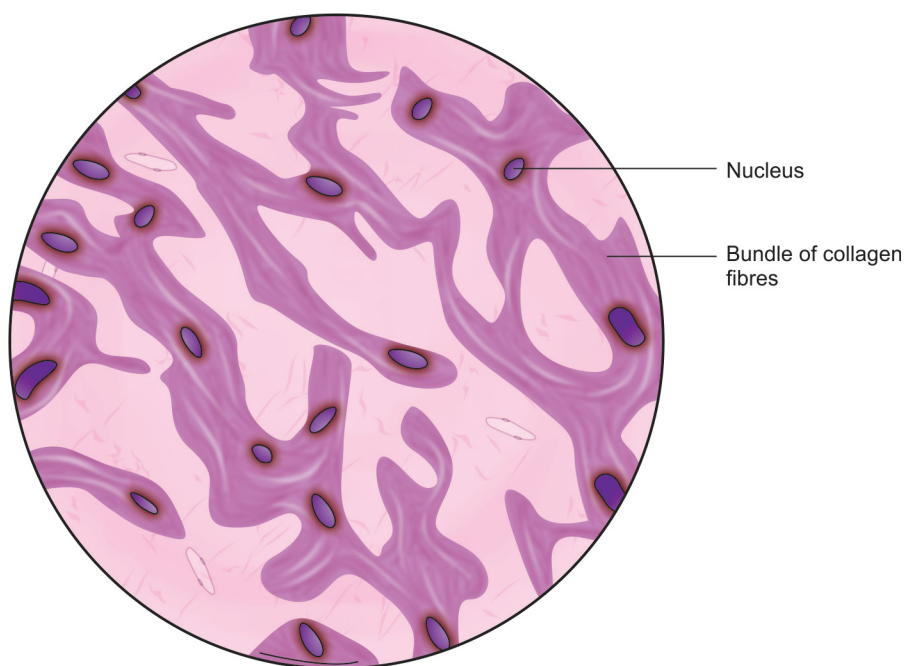
Lymph node. Stain: Reticulin stain, 100X

### 4. Myxomatous tissue

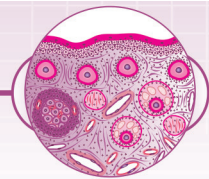
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Umbilical cord. Stain: Haematoxylin-eosin, 100X
